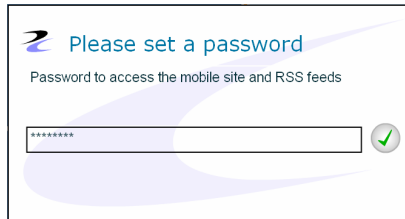


REFLECT Mobile: Features

To access REFLECT Mobile from your mobile phone, you will need to access your account from a computer first.



This screen will pop-up when you first log in to REFLECT Online. Creating a password here will enable you to use REFLECT Mobile. This can be the same as your IfL password. Normally we would recommend a 'strong' password but as it can be very difficult typing mixed case

passwords on some devices you might consider choosing a longer, single-case password.

If you have previously set a password but can't remember it you can access it through the **tools > settings** menu in REFLECT. Once in settings click on the key/tools icon in the bottom toolbar.

This will open the password page where you can add or amend your 'second' password.



This is the first screen of REFLECT Mobile. You can log in here once you have set a password in REFLECT Online.

The URL is <http://reflect.ifl.ac.uk/mobile> and can be accessed with any browser – though it is optimised for use with very simple browsers typically found on mobile devices and phones.

Because your phone or device is connecting to the internet you may incur data charges.

Your username is the one given to you by the IfL, usually your membership number (your email will not work as your username). Your password is the one you have created.



The REFLECT Mobile site will support:

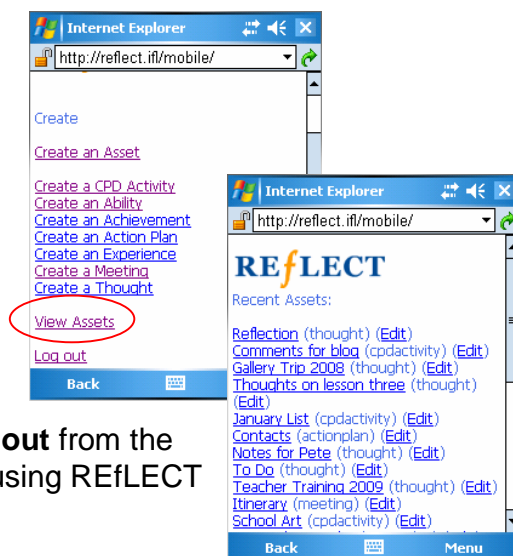

Create an Asset creates a simple asset with only the required fields – **title** and **description**. To create assets with full feature sets, select the asset type, for example **Create a Thought**.

When you save an asset it will save to your REFLECT account; additionally you can choose to post your new asset to a blog or CPD record on saving – these will appear in the **send to** drop-down box.



You can view your assets by selecting **View Assets** from the main menu screen.



At the bottom of the menu screen, you can **Log out** from the site. Remember to do this whenever you finish using REFLECT Mobile.
